The restrictions apply and, what's more, they are also introduced in neighboring countries. We are not able to guarantee the possibility of return for students who decide to leave, the situation is changing dynamically. We count on your understanding and common sense.

I would like to inform you

that from March 29, 2021 to April 9, 2021, all Reading Rooms of the Main Library and Faculty Reading Rooms are closed.

During a visit to the Main Library, the following rules apply:

The limit of one person per 15 m2, which means that only two people can visit a designated stand on the ground floor of the Main Library at the same time.

The obligation to cover the nose and mouth.

The obligation to disinfect hands when entering the Main Library.

The employees of the Main Library are on duty in accordance with the Announcement No. 6 of the Director of the Main Library of 08/03/2021.

INFO: Yesterday (March 29, 2021), unified quarantine rules for arrivals and returns from abroad were announced

The situation related to the increased number of COVID-19 cases is very dynamic. Therefore, yesterday (March 29, 2021), unified quarantine rules for arrivals and returns from abroad were announced, both for land and air transport. The new rules apply from today (March 30, 2021).

According to the information confirmed today by the border guard: Students, participants of postgraduate studies, specialist education and other forms of education are not required to undergo quarantine after crossing the border and are not required to have a negative test result for SARS-CoV-2 (Regulation of the Council of Ministers dated March 19, 2021 paragraph 3.2 point 9 amended by the Regulation of the Council of Ministers dated March 29, 2021.)

When travelling: Please take a student ID with you to be able to confirm the fact of studying at the Częstochowa University of Technology.

What changes?

Rules for travellers coming to Poland from the Schengen area:

Travellers will be quarantined unless they test negative for COVID-19. The test will have to be done no later than 48 hours before crossing the border.

Test type: PCR or antigenic.

The new rules apply to all means of transport: collective and individual transport as well as crossing the border on foot.

Travelers who have been quarantined in Poland will be able to take a test, the negative result of which will release them from quarantine.

Rules for travellers coming to Poland from outside the Schengen area:

Each traveller will be in quarantine.

The test done in the country from which the person comes from will not be eligible for release from quarantine.

Travellers who have been quarantined may take a test in Poland, the negative result of which will release them from quarantine.

Test type: PCR or antigenic.

The vaccine will release you from quarantine

People vaccinated against COVID-19 will be released from quarantine. This will apply to people who have been issued a certificate of vaccination with a vaccine that has been authorized in the European Union.

NEW REGULATION IN DORMS: "Register of departures and arrivals"

Dear Students, starting from 1st of April 2021 every resident leaving the dormitory and returning after leaving is required to write the date and time of leaving the dormitory in the "Register of departures and arrivals", and after returning - the date and time of return. The relevant "Register of departures and arrivals of residents" will be available on the dormitory's reception desk. Absences longer than those resulting from typical, everyday activities need to be registered. Please remember to complete this formality in order to avoid any problems upon your return.

INFO: Rector's announcement dated 26.03.2021

Dear Students,

Today (26.03.2021), the Rector of the Czestochowa University of Technology <u>announced</u>, that due to the worsening epidemic situation:

- from the 27th of March till the 1st of April 2021 and from the 10th of April till the 13th of April 2021, all classes conducted at the university in stationary mode (in direct contact) in full-time and part-time studies will be **converted into on-line classes**;
- from the 2nd of April to the 5th of April 2021, in accordance with the structure of the academic year, there is an Easter break days off from classes;
- from the 6th of April till the 9th of April 2021, there are days off from classes (in accordance with Rector's order 105/2021 dated 24 March 2021) we informed about it yesterday.

Further guidance will be provided on the 13th of April 2021.

We kindly ask you to follow all safety rules and take care of your health! (Today, 26.03.2021: 35 143 new positive covid tests)

INFO: press conference (25.03.2021) - tightening of security rules from 27th of March till 9th of April

The current situation in Poland (25.03.2021: 34 151 new positive covid tests) requires decisive action. From Saturday, the 27th of March, new safety rules will be introduced. They will be valid until the 9th of April, which means they will also cover the Easter period.

The difficult situation related to COVID-19 requires limiting our social activity - also during the upcoming Easter. Therefore, we should limit our contacts, and postpone any meetings and unnecessary travels to another, more secure time.

What will change from Saturday, the 27th of March?

- Trade: Large-format furniture and construction stores with an area of more than 2,000 m2 will be closed. Shopping centers and malls as at present, but in shopping centers, at the market or at the post office, new limits will apply: 1 person per 15 m2 in shops up to 100 m2, 1 person per 20 m2 in shops over 100 m2.
- **Religious worship (churches)** new limit 1 person per 20 m2. The obligation to cover the mouth and nose and keep 1.5 m away from other people remains unchanged.
- Hairdressing and beauty salons closed throughout Poland.

- Nurseries and kindergartens due to the safety of children and parents closed. (An exception
 only for the care of children of medics and law enforcement: including soldiers, police officers and
 fire brigades).
- Remote work wherever possible

Other restrictions - unchanged

Remember to keep your distance, disinfect your hands, wear a mask and ventilate the rooms frequently.
